

A New Bus Service for our Ward

We fought for, and won, a brand-new scheduled bus service for you!

We would like to thank Newport Bus, the former Cabinet Member for Infrastructure (Cllr Lacey) and the Residents bus group for their hard work in making it happen too.

It serves Duffryn, Coedkernew, Marshfield and Wentlooge and began operating in [April]. The bus will run:

- 31A, Royal Gwent Hospital, Docks Way, Lighthouse road, Morgan Way, Asda, Celtic Springs, Castleton. Marshfield, Peterstone, St Brides, Lighthouse Park
- 31C, via Royal Gwent Hospital, Docks Way, Lighthouse Road, Morgan Way, Asda, Lighthouse park, St Brides, Peterstone, Marshfield, Castleton, Celtic Springs.

In the past 12 months, since our last newsletter, we have also achieved:

Duffryn play areas: Celtic Horizons playpark upgrade (see below). Bus shelter: A replacement bus shelter at Castleton is approved and is in the work schedule. Fly tipping removal: Following reports of fly tipping on Pound Hill embankment, we worked to determine the ownership/responsibility for the land and ensued the removal of the will fly tipping. **Waste enforcement:** We are pleased that enforcement officers from Newport CC will be attending each community council to explain their role and how residents can help.

Lighthouse car park: We pressed for and achieved increased security measures at the Council car park adjacent to the former Lighthouse pub.
